# Spreading awareness & combating the stigma surrounding Alzheimer's disease





This week, Pamela Baker Gratton, presented to CBR about the Alzheimer's Association CNY Chapter, which is working hard to spread awareness about Alzheimer's and other dementia to communities in Central New York, and provide services to those individuals either living with the disease or to the caregivers of loved ones with it. There are 440,000 people in New York (7 Million Nationally) living with some form of dementia. Dementia is merely a symptom with many potential diseases that may cause it, one of which is Alzheimer's, a disease for which there are currently more questions than answers about the cause or cure. We are entering the treatment phase with promising advancement in research and new medications. Pamela emphasized the importance of bringing education to communities to help increase the rate of early, correct diagnoses that can help lead to these treatments sooner. 


