Amanda Giles: Creating Community Through CrossFit



CrossFit Cortland

Amanda Giles joined CBR this week to tell us about the incredible journey she has been on starting up and growing CrossFit Cortland! While serving in the NY State police, Amanda fell in love with the style of workouts provided there. Her CrossFit journey started in 2015, and upon the closure of the Seven Valleys CrossFit gym during the pandemic felt a void in Cortland of that caliber of a fitness community. After a hugely successful fundraising event held at the gym in the JM Murray Center, Amanda and her husband, Quentin, started up CrossFit Cortland in the Crescent Commons in March of 2021 with forty members. Not even four years later, membership is up to over 150 with 13 coaches. The goal of CrossFit Cortland is to provide functional fitness for everyone, no matter where they are on their fitness journey. Last year, CFC Nutrition was started as a means to provide more holistic guidance on health even outside of the gym. Most recently, they have taken over Common Grounds coffee shop and rebranded it as Lift a Latte with protein shakes available in addition to delicious coffee creations.

Most important of all, Amanda works hard to create community through CrossFit Cortland, not just for the members of the gym, but by giving back to the community through various fundraising efforts.



On January 11, 74 incredible members—from ages 5 to 70+—joined forces to honor Joshua and raise over \$7,000 for Cortland High School.
